



Volunteer Age Requirements *as of November, 2024*

Wellness Center:

- 18 years old and up
- Offer the option for minors (under 18) to tour the Wellness Center with a chaperoning adult

Education programs:

"Yes I Can" After-school Program

- 16 years-old with signed agreement/release from guardian
- Must be present with another team member over the age of 18
- YIC students' family/guardians must be made aware
- Child abuse and neglect training is required

Children's Learning Center

- 18 years-old and up
- Complete child abuse and neglect training.

Youth Financial Literacy Program

- 18 years-old and up
- Complete child abuse and neglect training.

English as a Second Language Program

- 16 years-old and up

GED Program

- 18 years-old and up
- Received HS diploma-*per Charleston County Adult Education*

Career Fairs

- 10 years old and up
- Adult chaperone required if under 18



Outreach Programs (and Facilities):

Direct service programs- *Food Pantry, Clothing Closet, Front Desk, and Maintenance/grounds projects.*

- 16 years old and up
- Supervising adult chaperone required if under the age of 18

Groups

- Students/ individuals must be in 7th grade and up
- One to five supervisor to child ratio
- All groups must complete a liability release waiver (Volunteer Services Coordinator will send out prior to volunteer day)

Soup Kitchen

- 16 years old and up
- Supervising adult chaperone required if under the age of 18
